 - Why did you choose to apply to be an Indiana SADD Student Leadership Council Member?
- Attach a recent photo to your application. If you would like the photo returned, please indicate so on your application.
- Provide a recommendation letter from your SADD advisor or principal for this position. The recommendation letter should be sealed in an envelope and initialed by the advisor or principal before collected and mailed in with the application.
- All applicants should be prepared for a phone interview. If an interview is necessary, Indiana SADD will call and schedule a time that is convenient for both you and an Indiana SADD employee.

*Please note: if any application is not complete according to these stipulations, it may not be considered.

All applications must be postmarked by February 11, 2009.
Notification of the selection results will be mailed by March 18, 2009.



Indiana SADD Student Leadership Council Requirements

SLC member requirements:

- Each SLC must attend the Indiana SADD/ Orange Ribbon Celebration 2009 on April 24, 2009.
- Each SLC must have a current email address that is checked **weekly**.
- Each SLC must make a concerted effort to attend all trainings and meetings scheduled, including the SADD National Conference 2009 in Washington D.C., July 12-15, 2009 (funding is available to subsidize a portion of all students' registration fees for the National Conference).
- Each SLC must be committed to living a SADD lifestyle.

If a requirement is not met, Indiana SADD may ask the SLC member to step down from his or her position.
